FOURTH GRADE EXIT EXPECTATIONS

Fourth Grade exit expectations for entrance into Fifth Grade These are the skills we desire parents to reinforce during the summer.

Students exiting **FOURTH GRADE** are expected in the area of **MATHEMATICS** to:

Master basic multiplication and division facts up to 12's.

Multiply 3 digit by 2 digit numbers.

Divide 2 and 3 digit numbers by a 1 digit divisor with remainders

State whole number place value up to the millions place

Round to the nearest 10, 100, and 1000 and nearest dollar amount

Select and use appropriate standard units to measure (inches, feet and yards)

Identify and describe different types of figures

- solids (i.e. cubes, spheres, cones etc.)
- polygons (i.e. triangles, quadrilaterals, hexagons, etc.)

Students exiting **FOURTH GRADE** are expected in the area of **READING** to:

Identify author's purpose (to entertain, inform, persuade)
Apply context clues to figure out the meaning of an unknown word
Be able to identify the genre of a story
Write a one paragraph summary of a story using the four main elements of a story
(characters, setting, problem, and solution)
Identify antonyms and synonyms
Identify the main idea of a passage
Differentiate between fact and opinion

Students exiting <u>FOURTH GRADE</u> are expected in the area of LANGUAGE ARTS/ WRITING to:

Identify parts of an expository essay Recognize and use nouns, verbs, and adjectives Use proper conventions in writing including indentation, capitalization, and punctuation

Students exiting FOURTH GRADE are expected in the area of STUDY SKILLS to:

Utilize an assignment notebook independently Utilize a dictionary, glossary, and thesaurus Read and understand a basic outline
